







SWACHH BHARAT MISSION GRAMEEN AN ACHIEVEMENT OF RESILIENCE

PHASE-I ACHIEVEMENTS

- Over 100 million individual household toilets constructed
- Rural sanitation coverage increased from 39 per cent in 2014 to 100 per cent in 2019

PHASE-II ACHIEVEMENTS

- Over 11.65 crore household toilets built till date
- 3.95 lakh villages reported with arrangement of Solid Waste Management
- 4.96 lakh villages reported with arrangement of Liquid Waste Management
- · 5.53 lakh villages declared ODF Plus
 - Aspiring: 2.34 lakh villages
 - Rising: 2,60,66 villages
 - Model: 2.93 lakh villages

IMPACT OF SBM-G

- 3 lakh diarrheal deaths avoided between 2014 and 2019 (WHO)
- 58 per cent higher cases of wasting among children reported in non-ODF areas (BMGF)
- 93 per cent women reported feeling safer (UNICEF)
- INR 50,000 saved annually by a household (UNICEF)
- 12.70 times less likelihood of groundwater contamination reported traceable to humans (UNICEF)
- 60,000-70,000 child deaths averted annually (Nature)
