OVERVIEW

The Panchayati Raj Day 2025 celebration stood out as a powerful demonstration of grassroots democracy in action, with unprecedented participation and collective enthusiasm across rural India. Over 15,06,000 participants actively engaged in Swachh Bharat Mission Grameen and Jal Jeevan Mission activities, reflecting the community's deep commitment to building a Swachh and Swasth Bharat. From spirited awareness drives to structured Gram Sabha discussions, the event reaffirmed the essential role of local governance in accelerating sanitation and water security goals.

Across the country, WASH (Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene) discussions in Gram Sabhas were conducted at scale, creating space for dialogue, planning, and resolution. Communities came together to take the Pledge for WASH Sustainability, pass Resolutions and Certifications for WASH assets, display details of Village Water and Sanitation Committee (VWSC) members, and strengthen WASH–Health–Nutrition linkages through integrated activities. These engagements fostered a deeper sense of ownership and responsibility among rural citizens, bringing sanitation and water issues to the forefront of local development agendas.

In addition to structured deliberations, the celebration was marked by dynamic and participatory events, and felicitation ceremonies added vibrancy to the campaign, drawing participation from all age groups. Special emphasis was laid on highlighting the WASH Gram Panchayats and honouring the vital contributions of sanitation workers, often the silent champions of clean communities.

These efforts reinforced the importance of safe hygiene practices and empowered communities to take proactive steps toward improved health outcomes.

It showcased how empowered local institutions, supported by active citizen participation and convergence across missions, can drive meaningful transformation. 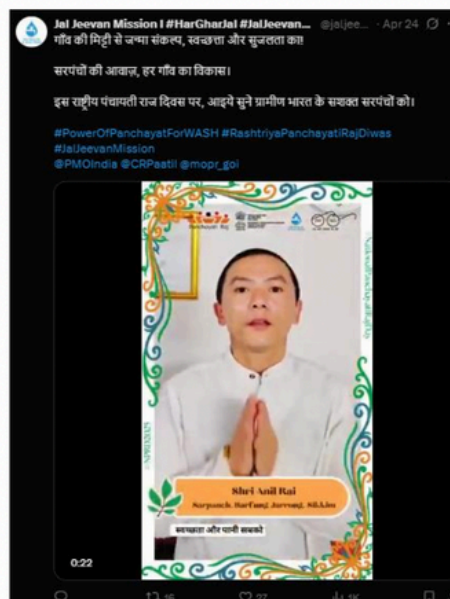

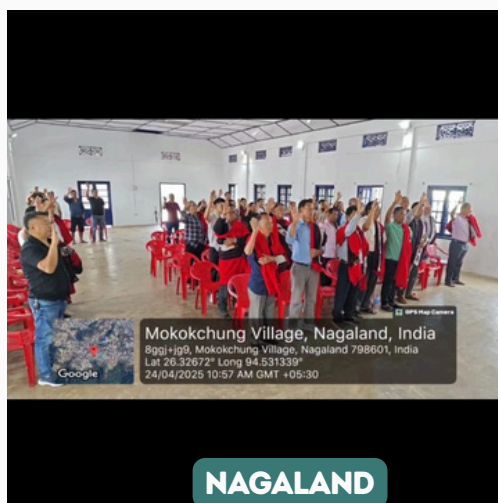
