

Executive Summary

Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation (DDWS), Ministry of Jal Shakti in collaboration with the Ministry of Culture, organized the Har Ghar Tiranga, Har Ghar Swachhata campaign from 8–15 August 2025. The initiative combined national pride with sanitation, mobilizing 2.6 crore citizens across 30 States/UTs, 581 districts, and 3.21 lakh villages. Communities actively participated in activities such as drain cleaning, greywater management, water leakage fixing, and plastic waste collection drives, with over 2.15 lakh villages conducting plastic management drives and 91,000+ citizens joining these drives.

WASH sites were cleaned and decorated, flag hoistings were conducted at Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) and Swachh Bharat Mission- Grameen (SBM-G) infrastructure, and Swachh Sujal Gaon pledges were taken. Awareness efforts included Swachhata dialogues and widespread community engagement through rallies, rangolis, wall paintings, and cultural events. On social media, the campaign gained strong traction, with over 13,000 posts, reaching 52 million with 4,37,000 impressions under #HarGharSwachhata, further amplifying its message.

Leadership from the Hon'ble Minister of Jal Shakti, Shri C.R. Patil, and the Secretary, DDWS, Shri Ashok K.K. Meena, ensured wide participation and visibility. States showcased innovative efforts, from menstrual hygiene initiatives in Chhattisgarh and e-rickshaw waste collection in Gujarat to eco-friendly Independence Day celebrations in Maharashtra and SHG-led cleaning drives in Meghalaya.

The campaign successfully demonstrated how patriotism and swachhata can reinforce each other, strengthening the vision of a clean, sujal, and inclusive India.






